Title: Postal markings used in Fredericton, New Brunswick during the stampless period, pre-1851.

Brief description of exhibit: The first post office was established in Fredericton in 1785 when the seat of government was moved there from St. John. A few early dated letters are known to exist, but no postal markings from Fredericton prior to 1795 have been recorded. This exhibit contains examples of the postal markings used in Fredericton from 1795 to September 5, 1851, the date when the first New Brunswick pence stamps went on sale.
