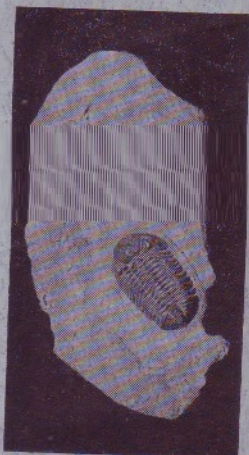

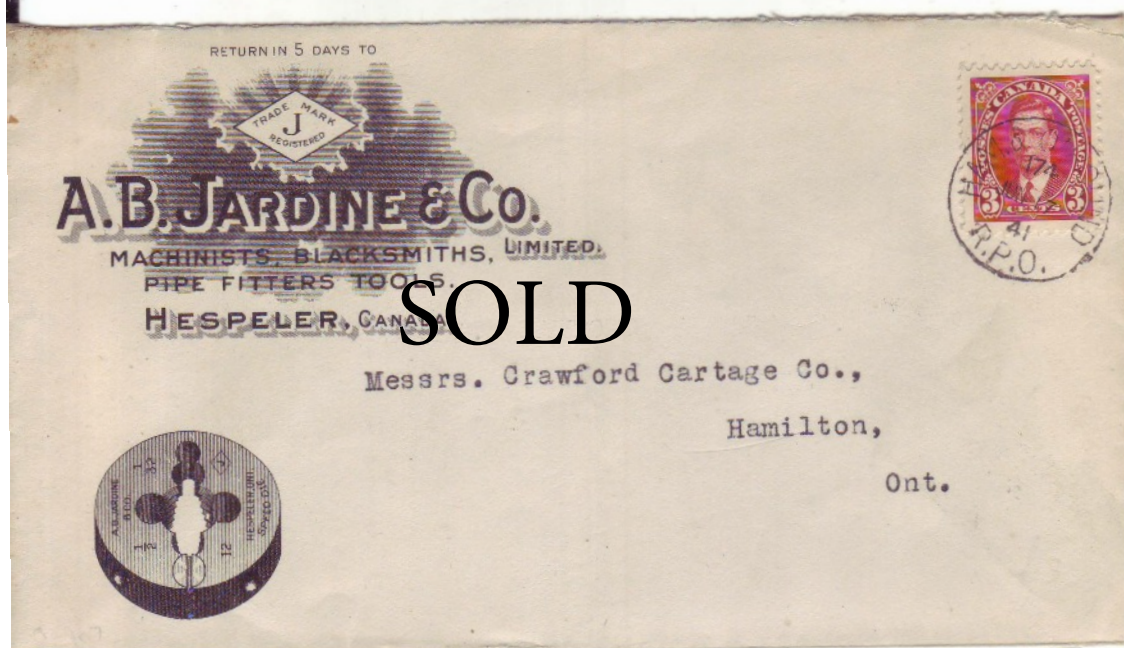

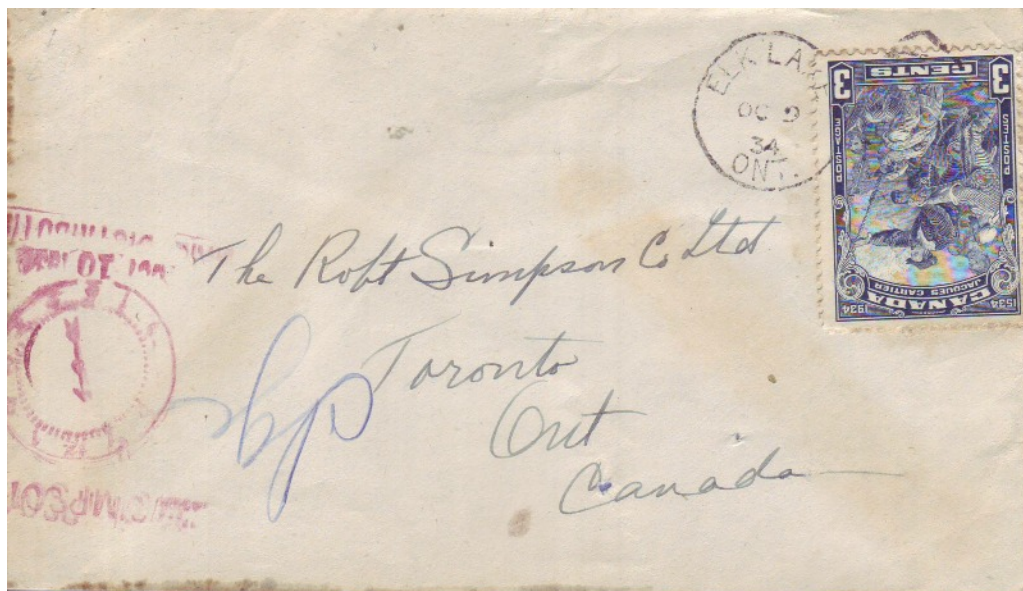

FIELD CENSOR 2715' and crown in the centre. Crease down left side and slightly dog-eared. £1.00
